Scape: 21.7 to 27.6in (55.1 to 70.1cm) high; green

Flower: 2.8in (7.1cm) long; pale lavender, lavender stripes; tubular; Suffolk, England; 7/15 - 8/20 - 9/15

Seed: sets viable seeds, green pods
