Leaf: 10in (25.4cm) long; 7in (17.8cm) wide; 13 to 14 vein pairs; medium green streaked with light green, greenish yellow, pale yellow, creamy white heavily rippled margins; slightly shiny on top; glaucous bloom underneath; broadly ovate with cordate base; lightly wavy, lightly corrugated

Scape: 25 to 29in (63.5 to 73.7cm) high; glaucous green

Scape Bracts: inflorescence leaves

Flower: 2in (5.1cm) long; pale lavender, ; tubular; Ann Arbor, MI; 6/29 - 7/12 - 7/25

Seed: sets viable seeds, glaucous green pods

Clump History: original seedling; 4 years old; Ann Arbor, MI

Notable Characteristics: heavily rippled mom, multicolored glaucous leaves of good substance
