Leaf: 4in (10.2cm) long; 2.5in (6.4cm) wide; 6 vein pairs; medium green with .75in (1.9cm) wide, pure white, slightly rippled margins; slightly shiny on top; slightly shiny underneath; ovate with tapered to flat base; lightly cupped, moderately twisted, lightly folded, moderately wavy, lightly flat

Scape: 18 to 24in (45.7 to 61.0cm) high; dark purplish green

Flower: 2in (5.1cm) long; pale to deep purple, ; tubular; Zionsville, IN; 7/8 - 7/15 - 8/10
