Plant: 13in (33.0cm) diameter; 8in (20.3cm) high; mound-like; medium to fast growth rate

Leaf: 5in (12.7cm) long; 1.25in (3.2cm) wide; 5 vein pairs; medium green flat margins; very shiny on top; dull underneath; lance with Tapered base; moderately folded, moderately wavy

Scape: 36 to 0in (91.4 to 0.0cm) high; purple

Scape Bracts: inflorescence leaves

Flower: 1in (2.5cm) long; medium lavender, ; tubular; Mansfield, OH; - -

Seed: sets viable seed, purple pods

Clump History: original seedling; 3 years old; Mansfield, OH

Notable Characteristics: unique little hosta with leaves seen to have points at the end of the ruffles, the green leaves stand out from the plant like spines, seed pods are an unusual glaucous purple
