Scape: 27.5 to 31.5in (69.9 to 80.0cm) high; soft green

Flower: 1.625in (4.1cm) long; pale lavender, ; tubular; Zwolle, Holland; 8/1 - - - 9/15

Seed: sets viable seed, green pods
