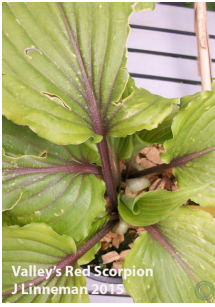

Plant: 35.375in (89.9cm) diameter; 27.5in (69.9cm) high; upright; fast growth rate

Leaf: 9in (22.9cm) long; 7.125in (18.1cm) wide; 7 vein pairs; medium green slightly rippled margins; slightly shiny on top; slightly shiny underneath; ovate with rounded base; moderately twisted, deeply folded, moderately wavy

Scape: 31.5 to 35.375in (80.0 to 89.9cm) high; red

Scape Bracts: N/A

Flower: 1in (2.5cm) long; pale purple, ; tubular; Zwolle, Holland; 8/1 - - 9/15

Seed: sets viable seed, red pods

Clump History: original seedling; 4 years old; Zwolle, Holland

Notable Characteristics: big elegant hosta with green wavy leaves, red of the petioles runs far into the leaves and veins

Pod Parent: Valley's seedling

Pollen Parent: Valley's seedling

Sport Parent: N/A

Seasonal Color Change: red of the petioles disappears during the growing season
