Plant: 48in (121.9cm) diameter; 20in (50.8cm) high; upright; medium to fast growth rate

Leaf: 14in (35.6cm) long; 9.5in (24.1cm) wide; 13 to 15 deeply incised vein pairs; intensely blue green with a metallic sheen wavy margins; very shiny on top; glaucous bloom underneath; broadly ovate with cordate base; moderately wavy

Scape: 36 to 38in (91.4 to 96.5cm) high; green

Scape Bracts: inflorescence leaves

Flower: 2 to 3in (5.1cm) long; pure white, ; tubular; Rosville, MN; July 15 to Aug 15

Seed: sets viable seeds, blue-green pods

Clump History: original seedling; 4 years old; Rosville, MN

Notable Characteristics: huge wavy edged leaves with shinny metallic sheen; astonishing color change; deep veins

Pod Parent: H. sieboldiana hybrid from RHS

Pollen Parent: unknown

Sport Parent: N/A

Seasonal Color Change: emerges gold in May and changes to blue-green by July
