Leaf: 9.75in (24.8cm) long; 7.5in (19.1cm) wide; 13 vein pairs; green heavily rippled margins; thin glaucous bloom underneath; broadly ovate with cordate base; deeply corrugated; deeply veined

Scape: 36 to 0in (91.4 to 0.0cm) high
