Plant: 36in (91.4cm) diameter; 17in (43.2cm) high; mound-like; medium to fast growth rate

Leaf: 8.5in (21.6cm) long; 6in (15.2cm) wide; 8 to 9 vein pairs; intensely blue-green moderately rippled margins; glaucous bloom on top; glaucous bloom underneath; broadly ovate with rounded base; moderately folded, moderately wavy

Scape: 28 to 0in (71.1 to 0.0cm) high; green

Scape Bracts: inflorescence leaves

Flower: 1.25in (3.2cm) long; medium lavender, ; tubular; Mansfield, OH; 9/15 - - 9/3

Seed: sets viable seed, glaucous green pods

Clump History: original seedling; 5 years old; Mansfield, OH

Notable Characteristics: leaf has a strong stiff appearance starting with a strong wavy edge, deeply veined surface ending with a full twist at its end, blue color reminds one of winter frost
