S. & S. Zolock (ONIR)

Plant: 40in (101.6cm) diameter; 24in (61.0cm) high; upright and mound-like; moderate growth rate

Leaf: 12in (30.5cm) long; 8in (20.3cm) wide; 13 to 15 vein pairs; yellow moderate ripple margins; ovate with flat base; moderately corrugated

Scape: 30 to 36in (76.2 to 91.4cm) high

Scape Bracts: inflorescence leaves

Flower: near white, pale lavender wash; bell; Belle Vernon, PA; 7/1 - 7/15 - 8/1

Seed: sets viable seeds, green pods

Clump History: the original seedling; 6 years old; Belle Vernon, PA

Notable Characteristics: deep veins on leaf underside, disease and insect resistant, distinct vein pattern on top of leaf

Pod Parent: seedling

Pollen Parent: seedling
