Plant: 50in (127.0cm) diameter; 33in (83.8cm) high; mound-like; fast growth rate

Leaf: 15in (38.1cm) long; 10in (25.4cm) wide; 15 vein pairs; yellow slightly to heavily rippled margins; very shiny on top; dull underneath; ovate with cordate base; folded

Scape: 27 to 34in (68.6 to 86.4cm) high; green

Scape Bracts:

Flower: tubular; Indianapolis, IN; - -

Seed: sets viable seeds, green pods

Clump History: the original seedling; 11 years old; Indianapolis, IN

Notable Characteristics: huge size and upright mounding growth, long huge leaves and shine, turns very golden yellow, bright green veining
