Plant: 37in (94.0cm) diameter; 20in (50.8cm) high; upright; moderate growth rate

Leaf: 11.75in (29.8cm) long; 9in (22.9cm) wide; 14 to 15 prominent undern vein pairs; dark green with unstable streaks of light green, blue green and greenish yellow with .5 to 1.25in (1.3 to 3.2cm) wide, pale yellow, slightly rippled margins; slightly shiny on top; glaucous bloom underneath; broadly ovate with cordate base; lightly cupped, lightly wavy, deeply corrugated and deeply leathery

Scape: 24 to 29in (61.0 to 73.7cm) high; green streaked yellow

Scape Bracts: inflorescence leaves

Flower: 1.75in (4.4cm) long; near white, near white with translucent margins; tubular; Ann Arbor, MI; 6/19 - 7/12 - 7/25

Seed: sets viable seeds, green or streaked pods

Clump History: original seedling; 7 years old; Ann Arbor, MI

Notable Characteristics: large, leathery, multi-colored, horizontally-held leaves; thick petioles
