Plant: 28in (71.1cm) diameter; 25in (63.5cm) high; mound-like; moderate growth rate

Leaf: 10.75in (27.3cm) long; 9.25in (23.5cm) wide; 12 to 13 vein pairs; dark green with unstable streaks of varying shades of yellow slightly rippled margins; dull on top; glaucous bloom underneath; nearly round with cordate base; deeply corrugated and moderately wavy

Scape: 18 to 26in (45.7 to 66.0cm) high; glaucous green

Scape Bracts: inflorescence leaves

Flower: 1.9in (4.8cm) long; pale lavender, purple striped and translucent margins; tubular; Ann Arbor, MI; 6/22 - 7/10 - 7/18

Seed: sets seeds, viability is unknown, light green pods

Clump History: original seedling; 6 years old; Ann Arbor, MI

Notable Characteristics: large corrugated leaves with yellow streaks and white backs

Pod Parent: F-1 seedling of H. 'Dorothy Benedict'
