Leaf: 4.33in (11.0cm) long; 1.97in (5.0cm) wide; 3 to 4 vein pairs; creamy white with .20 to .39in (0.5 to 1.0cm) wide, dark and medium green, heavily rippled margins; slightly shiny on top; slightly shiny underneath; ovate with tapered base; lightly twisted and deeply wavy overall.

Scape: 9.8 to 16in (24.9 to 40.6cm) high; light green

Flower: 1.97in (5.0cm) long; medium lavender, ; tubular; Kladno, Central Bohemia, Czech Republic; 7/10 - 8/1 - 8/20
