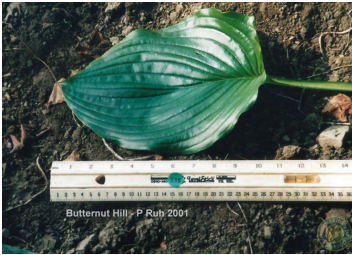

Plant: 27in (68.6cm) diameter; 20.5in (52.1cm) high; mound-like; moderate growth rate

Leaf: 11.5in (29.2cm) long; 8.5in (21.6cm) wide; 10 prominent vein pairs; yellow green slightly rippled margins; very shiny on top; dull underneath; ovate with flat base; flat and moderately wavy

Scape: 35 to 37in (88.9 to 94.0cm) high; pale green

Scape Bracts: inflorescence leaves

Flower: 2.5in (6.4cm) long; near white, ; bell; Chesterland, OH; 7/13 - 7/28 - 8/10

Seed: sets viable seeds, green pods

Clump History: division of original; 5 years old; Chesterland, OH

Notable Characteristics: unique color changes; name of originator's nursery

Pod Parent: H. hypoleuca

Pollen Parent: H. hypoleuca

Sport Parent: N/A

Seasonal Color Change: starts yellow-green; changes to green-gold; ends as a medium green
