Leaf: 8in (20.3cm) long; 5in (12.7cm) wide; 10 vein pairs; medium green flat margins; dull on top; slightly shiny underneath; broadly ovate with cordate base; lightly wavy, moderately corrugated, moderately flat

Scape: 18 to 20in (45.7 to 50.8cm) high; medium green

Scape Bracts:

Flower: 1.75in (4.4cm) long; pale lavender, light lavender with medium lavender striping; tubular; Manlius, NY; 7/28 - 8/10 - 8/19

Seed: medium green pods

Clump History: original seedling; 7 years old; Manlius, NY

Notable Characteristics: dull-leafed, medium sized, upright green hosta with purple petioles and striking striped flowers just above the foliage
