Leaf: 7in (17.8cm) long; 5in (12.7cm) wide; 9 to 10 vein pairs; medium green with 1in (2.5cm) wide, white, flat margins; dull on top; glaucous bloom underneath; broadly ovate with cordate base; moderately cupped, moderately corrugated

Scape: 12 to 17in (30.5 to 43.2cm) high; medium green with purple spotting

Scape Bracts:

Flower: 2in (5.1cm) long; pale lavender, medium lavender internal striping; tubular; Manlius, NY; 7/16 - 8/7 - 8/16

Seed: sets seeds viability is unknown, medium green pods
