Plant: 31in (78.7cm) diameter; 33in (83.8cm) high; mound-like; slow growth rate

Leaf: 7.5in (19.1cm) long; 7in (17.8cm) wide; 16 vein pairs; medium blue-green flat margins; glaucous bloom on top; glaucous bloom underneath; nearly round with cordate base; moderately cupped, moderately corrugated

Scape: 9 to 13in (22.9 to 33.0cm) high; medium green

Scape Bracts:

Flower: 1.5in (3.8cm) long; near white, light lavender striped; tubular; Manlius, NY; 6/26 - 7/10 - 7/20

Seed: seed set unknown

Clump History: the original seedling; 6 years old; Manlius, NY

Notable Characteristics: Medium-sized, blue-green hosta with nearly circular, cupped leaves, with flower scapes that barely protrude beyond the leaves
