Plant: 60in (152.4cm) diameter; 28in (71.1cm) high; upright; moderate growth rate

Leaf: 15in (38.1cm) long; 12in (30.5cm) wide; 13 to 16 vein pairs; greenish yellow slightly rippled margins; slightly shiny on top; glaucous bloom underneath; broadly ovate with cordate base; lightly wavy, lightly corrugated

Scape: 48 to 53in (121.9 to 134.6cm) high; green

Scape Bracts: inflorescence leaves

Flower: 2.5in (6.4cm) long; near white, pale lavender interior midrib stripe; tubular; Fayetteville, GA; 5/20 - - 7/15

Seed: sets viable seed, green pods

Clump History: original seedling; 8 years old; Fayetteville, GA

Notable Characteristics: very large upright light greenish yellow with a light glaucous bloom on leaf top in early spring and intensely white leaf backs
