Plant: 42in (106.7cm) diameter; 25in (63.5cm) high; mound-like; moderate growth rate

Leaf: 9.75in (24.8cm) long; 9.25in (23.5cm) wide; 13 prominent underneath vein pairs; golden yellow slightly rippled margins; slightly shiny on top; very shiny underneath; nearly round with cordate base; deeply corrugated and moderately cupped

Scape: 27 to 31in (68.6 to 78.7cm) high; greenish yellow

Scape Bracts: inflorescence leaves

Flower: 2.1in (5.3cm) long; pale lavender, translucent edge; tubular; Ann Arbor, MI; 6/28 - 7/12 - 7/21

Seed: sets seeds, viability is unknown, light green pods

Clump History: original seedling; 7 years old; Ann Arbor, MI

Notable Characteristics: deeply corrugated, cupped golden yellow leaf with good substance
